

## TENBY GOLF CLUB LOCAL RULES

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 18.2 APPLIES)** BEYOND THE FENCED BOUNDARIES OF THE COURSE AND:
  - A. IN OR BEYOND THE DITCH ON THE RIGHT OF THE 7<sup>TH</sup>, AND TO THE LEFT OF THE 16<sup>TH</sup>.
  - B. WITHIN THE ENCLOSED AREA OF BLACK ROCK COTTAGE.
  - C. BEYOND THE METAL FENCE/GATE ON THE LEFT OF THE 18<sup>TH</sup>.
  - D. THE CAR PARK AND AREA SURROUNDING THE CLUBHOUSE DEFINED BY WHITE POSTS OR LINES.
  - E. WHEN PLAYING THE 1<sup>ST</sup> AND 14<sup>TH</sup> HOLES, THE AREA BEYOND THE GREEN AS DEFINED BY WHITE POSTS.
  - F. ON THE BEACH.
  - G. THE GREENKEEPERS SHEDS AND YARD AREA BETWEEN THE 2<sup>ND</sup> AND 3<sup>RD</sup> HOLES DEFINED BY WHITE POSTS.  
A BALL COMING TO REST ON OR BEYOND THE FOOTPATH BEYOND THE 1<sup>ST</sup> GREEN OR BEYOND THE 14<sup>TH</sup> GREEN, AND BEYOND THE RAILWAY LINE AND FOOTPATH BETWEEN THE 14<sup>TH</sup> AND 15<sup>TH</sup> HOLES IS OUT OF BOUNDS, EVEN IF IT COMES TO REST ON ANOTHER PART OF THE COURSE THAT IS IN BOUNDS FOR OTHER HOLES.
2. **INTEGRAL OBJECTS (NO FREE RELIEF)**
  - A. PATHS OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFIED IN LOCAL RULE 4 BELOW.
  - B. ARTIFICIAL TURF STRUCTURES IN BUNKERS AND BUNKER SURROUNDS.
  - C. RETAINING ARTIFICIAL WALLS AND GATES TO THE LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE 18<sup>TH</sup> FAIRWAY.
3. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS:**

FOR A BALL IN THE GENERAL AREA, THE PLAYER MAY TAKE RELIEF UNDER RULE 16.1b IF AN IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION IS ON THE LINE OF PLAY, AND WITHIN TWO CLUB-LENGTHS OF **BOTH** THE PUTTING GREEN AND THE BALL. EXCEPTION – NO RELIEF IS AVAILABLE UNDER THIS LOCAL RULE WHEN THE LINE OF PLAY CHOSEN BY THE PLAYER IS CLEARLY UNREASONABLE.
4. **ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (INCLUDING IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS) (RULE 16).**
  - A. PATHS OR STEPS SURFACED WITH STONE CHIPPINGS, COARSE GRAVEL, COCKLESHELL PATHS, TARMACADAM SURFACES, OR RAILWAY SLEEPERS.
  - B. AREAS RE-SEEDING OR RE-TURFED INCLUDING WHEN NOT OTHERWISE MARKED, ARE TO BE TREATED AS NO PLAY ZONES IN GROUND UNDER REPAIR FROM WHICH RELIEF **MUST** BE TAKEN. NOTE: DOES NOT APPLY TO RE-SEEDING DIVOTS.
5. **PROHIBITING PLAY FROM FRINGE OF WRONG GREEN:**

WHEN THE PLAYER MUST TAKE RELIEF (UNDER RULE 13.1f) BECAUSE HIS OR HER BALL CAME TO REST ON A WRONG GREEN.

  - IN FINDING THE RELIEF AREA TO BE USED WHEN TAKING THIS RELIEF, THE PUTTING GREEN IS DEFINED TO INCLUDE THE AREA OF FAIRWAY WITHIN TWO CLUB LENGTHS FROM THE EDGE OF THE PUTTING GREEN.
  - THIS MEANS THAT THE NEAREST POINT OF COMPULSIVE RELIEF MUST AVOID INTERFERENCE FROM THIS AREA IN ADDITION TO THE PUTTING GREEN.
  - INTERFERENCE DOES NOT EXIST IF A WRONG GREEN ONLY INTERFERES WITH THE PLAYER'S STANCE.
6. **EMBEDDED BALL**

RULE 16.3 IS MODIFIED IN THIS WAY@ FREE RELIEF IS NOT ALLOWED WHEN A BALL IS EMBEDDED IN ARTIFICIAL STACKED TURF FACES.
7. **THE PREPARED AREA OF SAND ON HOLES 6, 14 AND 17 (IN FRONT OF THE TEEING AREA) ARE PART OF THE GENERAL AREA AND ARE NOT BUNKERS.**

### SUSPENSION OF PLAY DUE TO A DANGEROUS SITUATION (NOTE TO RULE 5.7b)

DISCONTINUE PLAY IMMEDIATELY:

ONE PROLONGED NOTE OF SIREN

DISCONTINUE PLAY:

THREE CONSECUTIVE NOTES OF SIREN, REPEATED

RESUME PLAY:

TWO SHORT NOTES OF SIREN REPEATED

**PLEASE NOTE:**

IF ANY PLAYER BELIEVES THERE IS DANGER FROM LIGHTNING THEY SHOULD DISCONTINUE PLAY IMMEDIATELY AS PER RULE 5.7b EVEN IF THE SIREN IS NOT SOUNDED.

IT IS THE DUTY OF EACH PLAYER TO ENSURE AS FAR AS PRACTICABLE THEIR OWN SAFETY AND THAT OF OTHERS ON THE COURSE, PLEASE BE AWARE OF THE POTENTIAL HAZARDS AS SPECIFIED ON THE HEALTH AND SAFETY NOTICEBOARD. ALWAYS REPLACE DIVOTS, SMOOTH BUNKERS REPAIR PITCHMARKS AND OBSERVE THE ETIQUETTE OF GOLF. NO GOLF TROLLEYS ON THE TEES.
